AVANT-GARDE armchair, design by Fabrice Berrux

The Avant-Garde armchair, designed by Fabrice Berrux, showcases simple lines and a carefully studied balance between full and empty spaces.

This design serves as a challenge to traditional notions of balance. The backrest and seat of the armchair are two distinct pieces made of single curved lines, connected by a metal rod. The space between these elements not only enhances the visual lightness but also creates a sense of suspension, contributing to an engaging interplay of balance.

The separation between the seat and the backrest is not merely a technical feat or an aesthetic choice; it also serves a functional purpose by providing the frame with a delicate flexibility. This design allows the two parts to adapt naturally to the body's shape, ensuring optimal comfort and a well-balanced seating experience.

With its distinctive style, the Avant-Garde armchair becomes a striking focal point in various settings. It is particularly effective in adding character to an unconventional living area, especially when paired with a pouf, and also fits seamlessly into elegant waiting rooms or hotel lounges.

The round seat acts as a counterpoint to the tubular element, which features an elliptical section that seamlessly extends from the backrest to the armrest, offering a fluid and enveloping embrace. The soft and enveloping backrest cushion adds a touch of relaxation.

Versatile and sophisticated, the Bull armchair can adapt to various settings. It works beautifully alongside a group of sofas in a living area or can stand alone or in pairs, whether in a bedroom or a dedicated corner for reading and rest.
